<p><b>Report</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Liver: normal in size and echo texture, normal intrahepatic bile ducts, no SOL, grade 1 fatty changes seen.</li> <li>- GB: normal wall thickness , no stone, no SOL</li> <li>- Spleen: normal in size and echo texture, no SOL .</li> <li>- Rt. Kidney: normal in size and position and texture, normal CMD, no stone, no hydronephrosis, no SOL, coarse gravel's seen.</li> <li>- Lt. Kidney: normal in size and position and texture, normal CMD, no stone, no hydronephrosis, no SOL, coarse gravel's seen.</li> <li>- urinary bladder: partially filled, no stone, no SOL</li> <li>- Prostate: normal in size , normal shape, no SOL</li> <li>- No enlarged LN seen</li> <li>- No free fluid seen</li> <li>- A blind ended structure seen at site of appendectomy stump at right iliac fossa region with thickened wall associated with increased surrounding mesenteric fat echogenicity, diameter is 5mm and compressible, ddx: early stump appendicitis? for clinical and lab correlations.</li> </ul>
